

# DEB ID Generation

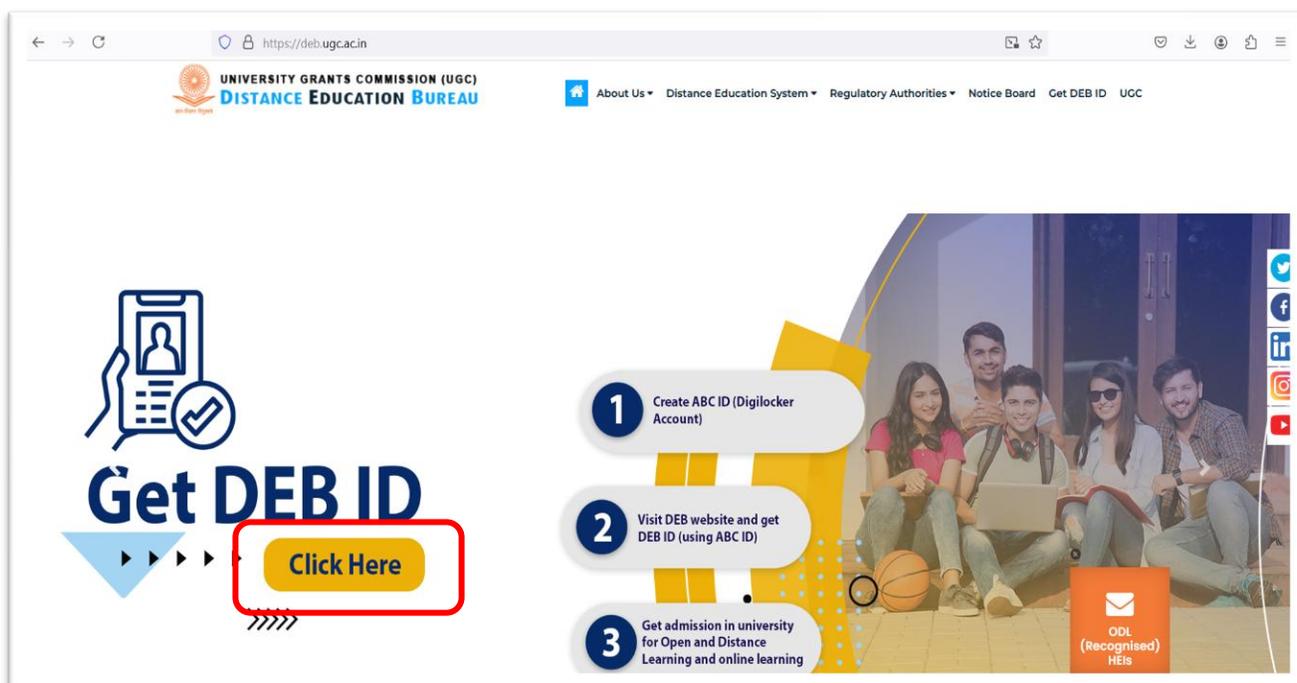
UGC-DEB has introduced a new admission procedure for all Open and Distance Learning (ODL) and Online Programmes, starting from the academic year 2024-25 and onwards:

- All learners must register on the UGC-DEB web portal to generate a unique DEB-ID before taking admission.
- To generate a DEB-ID, visit the UGC-DEB web portal (<https://deb.ugc.ac.in/> or <https://deb.ugc.ac.in/StudentDeBID> ) and generate DEB ID using your Academic Bank of Credit (ABC) ID
- If you do not have an Academic Bank of Credit (ABC) ID, you can create one through DigiLocker (<https://www.digilocker.gov.in> )
- The DEB-ID, once generated, will remain valid for the student's lifetime.
- Without a valid DEB-ID, admission cannot be granted to Open and Distance Learning (ODL) and Online Programmes.

## Steps to Generate DEB ID

### A. If You have Academic Bank of Credit (ABC) ID:

1. Go to the UGC-DEB portal (URL Link: <https://deb.ugc.ac.in/> ) or <https://deb.ugc.ac.in/StudentDeBID>)

2. Start filling the form to “Get Your DEB ID”: *(details of student to be filled here)*

- Enter your “ABC ID”(ensure it is correct).
- Fill your Name exactly as mentioned on the **Aadhaar Card** in the field “Enter Aadhaar Name.”
- Enter **Year of Birth** exactly as mentioned on your Aadhaar Card.
- Select your “Gender” from the drop-down menu.

3. Move to the next section **“Consent Given By;”** two options will be displayed:
  - Click on **“Self”** if the student is generating their own DEB ID.
  - Click on **“Other”** if someone else is generating the DEB ID on behalf of the student.

If **“Self”** is selected: Provider Name, Provider Authentication Mode, Provider Authentication ID No. and Consent Relation field will automatically be pre-filled according to your ABC ID.

If **“Other”** is selected: *(Only Mother, Father, Guardian, or Teacher are permitted to generate a DEB ID on behalf of the student)*

- **Enter the Provider Name;** The person generating the DEB ID must enter their name in the field **“Enter Provider Name”**, exactly as it appears in the selected Authentication Mode.
- Select **Authentication Mode** ; Choose the applicable option from the drop-down menu.
- Enter **“Authentication ID No.”**: submit the ID number corresponding to the selected Authentication Mode.

#### 4. Move to the next section “Enter Consent Place & Captcha”

- Enter “**Consent Place**”; can be the city as per your Aadhar Card
- Enter “**Captcha**” Code; Ttype the characters exactly as shown in the captcha image.
- Click on “**Enter**” to proceed further

#### 5. Final Step to “Generate DEB ID”

- **ABC ID** will already be pre-filled (as entered in Step 1).
- Student Name, Gender, and Date of Birth (DOB) will be auto-filled based on the ABC ID.
- **DEB ID status** will show as “*Not Yet Created.*”
- Enter “**Email ID**” and “**Mobile No.**”
- Check the box for “**I Agree**”.
- Click on “**Submit**” to generate your “**DEB ID**”.
- On successful submission, your DEB ID will be displayed in a dialog box

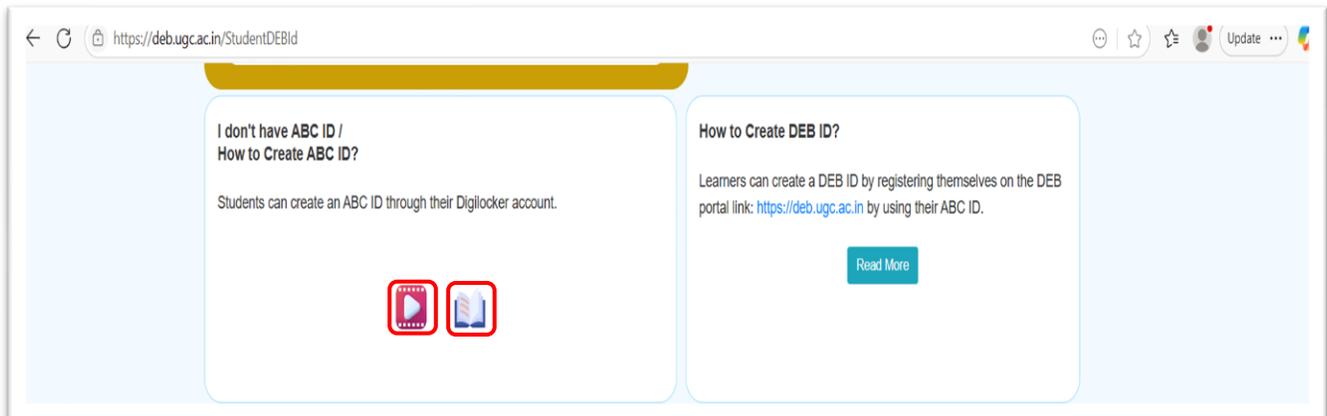
6. Note your DEB-ID for future reference and to proceed with your admission in LPU Online programs.
7. Log in to your Admission Portal using the credentials sent to your registered email ID by LPU Online during the lead generation process.
8. Enter your DEB ID in step 3 on the admission portal, submit the admission fee and complete your admission process.

## B. If You do not have Academic Bank of Credit (ABC) ID:

1. Go to the UGC-DEB portal (URL Link: <https://deb.ugc.ac.in/> ) or <https://deb.ugc.ac.in/StudentDeBID> )



2. Refer to the video by clicking the “**play icon**” for the generation of an ABC ID, or follow the step-by-step guide by clicking the “**book icon**”.
